

Coach Biographies

Ted Garber

Ted Garber is in his second season as an assistant coach for the Cannons.

Prior to the Cannons, Garber spent the 2006 season as an assistant coach for the expansion Chicago Machine. He was the head coach of the Bridgeport Barrage in 2001 and has also coached at both the collegiate and high school levels. Garber began his MLL coaching career at the league's inception. He was a coach during the 2000 MLL Summer Showcase Tour. He also guided the Barrage as head coach in the team's inaugural season.

In addition to working for the Machine in 2006 Garber has for the past 12 years coached at the Avon Old Farms School in Avon, Connecticut where his overall record was 106-55. He led the Avon Old Farms team to numerous Western New England titles and Founder's League Championships. He has been inducted into the University of New Hampshire Hall of Fame as a player and coach, and has been honored by the MLL for "outstanding contributions to the game of lacrosse as a top coach and clinician."

Brett Garber

Brett Garber, midfielder for the Boston Cannons, was captain of the UMASS varsity lacrosse team in 2007, finishing second on the team in goals and points. He was also selected as All-American, All-New England and All-ECAC during his senior year at UMASS.
